THE BOOK OF FIRST PETER "Biblical Holiness" (2) I Peter 1:13-17

- Intro. 1. When God's mind becomes my mind, and God's will becomes my will, and, according to the measure of my faith—I become holy.
 - Lack of conformation with the old life and separatist attitude toward the Lord from the ground of Biblical holiness.
 - 3. From the ground of holiness, God provides directions unto the experience of holiness. Some of these directions are in our text:
- 1. Specific exertion. "loins of mind"
 - a. The mental.
 - b. The sensual.
 - c. The crucial.
- 2. Specific moderation. "be sober"

This concerns self-control and Christian sobriety. The same eyes cannot look up to heaven and down to earth at the same time. The love of the world is inconsistent with Christian obedience.

- 3. Specific anticipation. "hope to the end"
 - a. Perfectly.
 - b. Experimentally.
 - c. Apocalyptically.

Assurance begets true holiness!

- 4. Specific disposition. "pass your time in fear"
 - a. Actively
 - b. Regularly
 - c. Reverently
- Concl. I put you in remembrance tonight with these blessed truths. It is futile to have directions and not use them. Become holy!
