#### The Book of Daniel

- We see several characteristics of Daniel throughout the book.
- Daniel the Man of God, esp. ch. 1 and 6
  - Holy and steadfast in conduct.
- Daniel the Servant of Kings, ch. 2-6
  - Interpreter of dreams and signs; wise leader.
- Daniel the Prophet of God, esp. ch. 7-12
  - Revealer of world kingdoms.

#### Characters

- Daniel: wisdom, righteousness, revelation
- Nebuchadnezzar: power, pride, humility (1-4)
- Astrologers: useless (2:10-11, 4:7)
- Belshazzar: pride (5)
- Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego: faithful (3)
- Darius: gullible and impetuous (6)

#### Characters

- The main character is God.
  - The hand of the Lord is prominent (1:2, 5:23, 9:15)
  - God gives dreams and provides interpretation (2, 4)
  - God protects His people (3=furnace, 6=lions' den)
  - God humbles the proud and orders kingdoms (4-5)
  - God gives revelation of the future (7-12)

#### Life and Times of Daniel

- Nebuchadnezzar reigned in Babylon 605–562
  BC.
  - His first incursion into Judah was in 605 BC.
- Daniel was a teenager, perhaps 18 years of age, when he was taken away to Babylon.
- He lived until at least 536 BC in the reign of Cyrus of Persia, into his late eighties.

## Life and Times of Daniel, cont.

- Daniel never returned. From 605 to 536 BC,
  Daniel experienced the full 70 years of
  captivity predicted by Jeremiah the prophet
  - Jer. 25:11-12, 29:10; Daniel 9:2; Zechariah 1:12.
- First return to Israel led by Zerubbabel in 536
  BC

## Life and Times: Compared to Jeremiah

- Jeremiah prophesied from 627 to 580 BC in Judah.
  - Daniel was taken in 605; chapters 1-3 happened before 580 BC.
  - Daniel's ministry began some time after Jeremiah but continued long after.
  - See Daniel 9:2, which shows that Daniel had
    Jeremiah's prophecy (all the way from Judah).

## Life and Times: Compared to Ezekiel

- Ezekiel prophesied 592 to 571 BC in Babylon.
  - Ezekiel was taken to Babylon in 597 BC during Nebuchadnezzar's second incursion to Israel.
  - His ministry is wholly contained inside the time period of Daniel's ministry.
  - By that time, even though Daniel was in his early 50s, he was renowned for his righteousness and wisdom.
  - See Ezekiel 14:13-20 and 28:3 for references to Daniel.

# Mentioned by Jesus

- See Matthew 24:15
- Daniel and his book are favorably mentioned by the Lord. Daniel's prophetic accuracy is thus confirmed.
