OUR BELIEFS

1. We believe the 66-book Bible is verbally inspired and inerrant in the original writings. We believe that the Bible must be interpreted literally, according to context, history, and grammar. We believe the dispensational approach to the Bible.
2. We believe there is one living and true God, eternally existing in three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

7. We believe in the imminent, pretribulational rapture of the church. We believe in the personal, premillennial return of the Lord Jesus to the earth to set up His Kingdom.

OUR STAFF



DEVOTIONAL READING - Iwo Jima and the Believer John 8:28-36

We have seen the photograph taken on the island of Iwo Jima. Six brave soldiers were caught in the act of raising the America flag. The message was clear: “We are claiming this territory for the United States of America. The Japanese no longer control this island; the United States does. The two Japanese air bases on this island will no longer be used against us.” This most famous and most reproduced photograph of all time was telling the world that this little island in the South Pacific was conquered by the United States of America.



As a believer in the Lord Jesus Christ, what do you tell the world about your own life? Do you show the world the flag of your risen Saviour? Do you show to the world the Overcomer who dwells within you? Do you proclaim that the island of your stubborn heart was conquered by Jesus Christ? This flag is unfurled in the circumcised heart (Phil. 3:3) of one who has been liberated by the living God. “Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal. The Lord knoweth them that are His. And, let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity” (2 Tim. 2:19).

Does the world see your transformed life—you whose soul has been set free? Do people see the flag of your victorious Lord or do they see the same old flag that the rest of the world flies? “Dear Father, I pray that I will not be ashamed to fly Your flag in my daily walk with You.
