OUR BELIEFS

1. We believe the 66-book Bible is verbally inspired and inerrant in the original writings. We believe that the Bible must be interpreted literally, according to context, history, and grammar. We believe the dispensational approach to the Bible.
2. We believe there is one only living and true God, eternally existing in three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

7. We believe in the imminent, pretribulational rapture of the church. We believe in the personal, premillennial return of the Lord Jesus to the earth to set up His Kingdom.

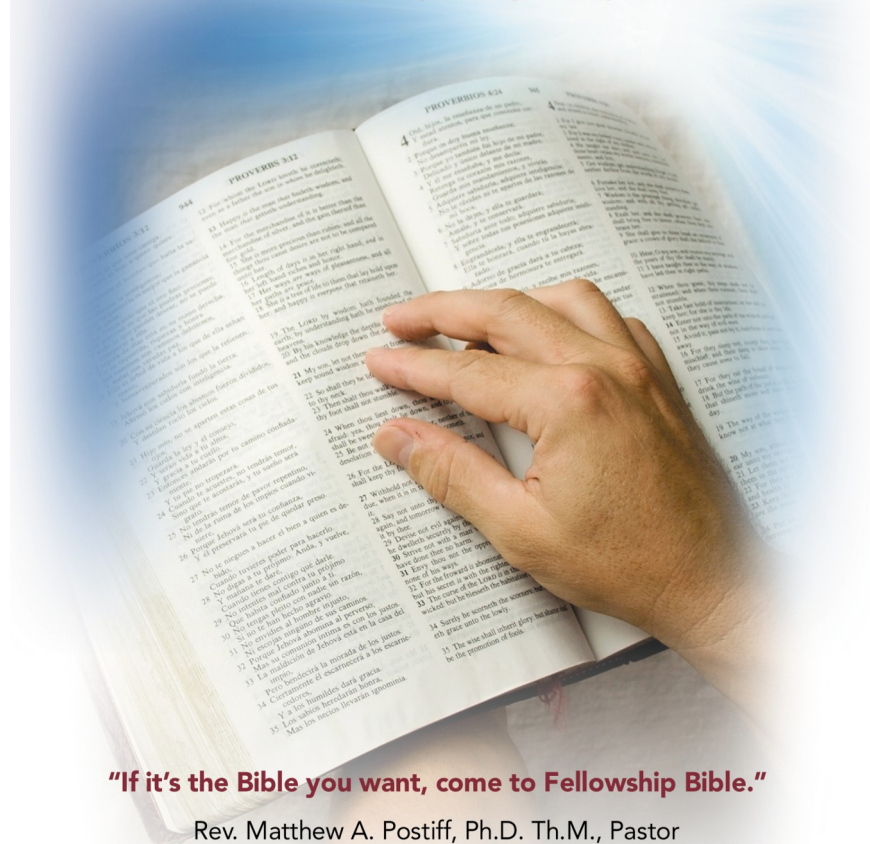

DEVOTIONAL READING – Quotes from F.B. Meyer (1847– 1929)

“The greatest tragedy of life is not unanswered prayer, but unoffered prayer.” - F. B. Meyer

How impacting is this statement on prayer! We are often quick to reference a prayer that is unanswered, but we are less likely to acknowledge our failure to pray.

James 4:2 exhorts us with these words: "Ye have not because ye ask not." Unoffered prayer robs us of the blessing of God's provision.

There are many verses that direct us to pray:

"Ask and it shall be given" - Matt. 7:7

"Whatever you ask in prayer" - Matt. 21:22

"Whatever you shall ask in my Name" - Jn. 14:13

"If ye ask anything according to His will" - 1 Jn. 5:14

“I used to think that God’s gifts were on shelves one above the other; and that the taller we grew in Christian character the easier we could reach them. I now find that God’s gifts are on shelves one beneath the other; and it is not a question of growing taller but of stooping lower; and that we have to go down, always down, to get His best gifts.”
