OUR BELIEFS



DEVOTIONAL READING - Which Are God's

"Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body. Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's." – 1 Corinthians 6:18-20

Our attitude toward temptation is directly related to the way in which we view our relationship with God. If we view Him as the absolute owner of our lives, our bodies and everything we have, then our desires must be subject to His commands. If we recognize that the Holy Spirit is constantly with us, then we must behave in ways that will honor and please Him rather than bringing shame and sorrow. "And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption" (Ephesians 4:30). The price that Jesus paid to pay for our sins was high, and we must not live in a way that disrespects His sacrifice.

Scottish pastor Thomas Boston wrote, "In vain will ye fast, and pretend to be humbled for our sins, and make confession of them if our love of sin be not turned into hatred; our liking of it into loathing; and our cleaving to it, into a longing to be rid of it; with full purpose to resist the motions of it in our heart, and the outbreakings thereof in our life; and if we turn not unto God as our rightful Lord and Master, and return to our duty again." The devil knows how to make sin look attractive to us, so we must keep our eyes fixed on God and our relationship with Him close and personal. The more we are like Him, the more we will hate sin, just as He does. The more we hate sin, the easier it will be for us to resist temptation. A Christian who grasps God's ownership of every part of his life is a Christian prepared to defeat temptation. – https://devo.paulchappell.com/which-are-gods
