OUR BELIEFS

1. We believe the 66-book Bible is verbally inspired and inerrant in the original writings. We believe that the Bible must be interpreted literally, according to context, history, and grammar. We believe the dispensational approach to the Bible.
2. We believe there is one only living and true God, eternally existing in three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

7. We believe in the imminent, pretribulational rapture of the church. We believe in the personal, premillennial return of the Lord Jesus to the earth to set up His Kingdom.

DEVOTIONAL READING

Faith: What It Is and What It Is Not Romans 4:16-25

Faith is only as valid as its object. You could have tremendous faith in very thin ice and drown. You could have very little faith in very thick ice and be perfectly secure.

The God of our salvation is faithful, dependable and trustworthy. No one who comes to Him will be cast out or turned away (John 6:37). No one who believes in Him will be disappointed or put to shame (Rom. 10:11). Anyone who rests down on Him will find a rock-solid foundation (1 Cor. 3:11).

Faith itself does not save anybody, Christ does. But faith puts a person in the place where God can save him, and God will only save those who believe (1 Cor. 1:21). God never asked us to trust our faith; He asked us to trust the Saviour and look to Him (Isa. 45:22). Our faith is no good unless it is rooted in Him.

A person asked, “Are you the woman with the great faith?” She answered, “No, I am the woman who has a little faith in a great God.”

Faith is not working for my salvation but it is resting upon the work of Another (Rom. 4:5). Faith is the hand of the heart that reaches out to receive God’s gift of salvation (Eph. 2:8). I’m saved if I believe; condemned if I don’t (John 3:18). Faith is not a leap in the dark; it is a leap out of darkness into the glorious light of the gospel (2 Cor. 4:4-6).

Whereas sinful men declare their independence from God, faith is my Declaration of Dependence. Paul manifested his faith when he said “for I believe God, that it shall be even as it was told me” (Acts 27:25).
