OUR BELIEFS

1. We believe the 66-book Bible is verbally inspired and inerrant in the original writings. We believe that the Bible must be interpreted literally, according to context, history, and grammar. We believe the dispensational approach to the Bible.
2. We believe there is one only living and true God, eternally existing in three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe that man was created in the image of God, but he sinned, and thereby all human beings are born with a sin nature which is at enmity with God. Man therefore needs to be reconciled to God, released from slavery to sin, and delivered from God's wrath against sin and the guilt of sin.
4. We believe in Christ's virgin birth, physical bodily resurrection, ascension, and present intercession for us.
5. We believe that Jesus Christ died in our place at Calvary and that His sacrifice is the only ground for forgiveness of sin.
6. We believe that salvation is by grace through faith in Jesus Christ, and that all who so believe are eternally saved, transformed, and being sanctified.
7. We believe in the imminent, pretribulational rapture of the church. We believe in the personal, premillennial return of the Lord Jesus to the earth to set up His Kingdom.

DEVOTIONAL READING – No Earthly Good? Colossians 3:1-13

“If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God. Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth” (Col. 3:1-2).

Every believer in Christ has been risen with Christ. Positionally, we are sitting with Christ Jesus in heavenly places (Eph. 2:6) and are partakers of the heavenly calling (Heb. 3:1). Our position should govern our practice.

A heavenly minded person will not neglect earthly responsibilities but will seek those things which have lasting eternal value. We have been risen with Christ, and thus we need to make sure that our interests are centered in Him.

We seek what we love. If we love money, we will seek to acquire treasures on earth. How we need to pursue heavenly riches! Christ should be the One we love more than anyone or anything else, and thus we should seek after His interests. We are also to set our minds on the things which are above. We are citizens of heaven (Phil. 3:20), living on earth as Christ’s ambassadors (2 Cor. 5:20), thinking thoughts that are worthy of our citizenship.

“Don’t be so heavenly minded that you are of no earthly good!” What a foolish statement! God commands us to be heavenly minded. Our main problem is that we are too earthly minded. We need to get our minds out of the sewers and garbage dumps of this world and focus on things of eternal value; for the things that are seen are temporal, but the things that are not seen are eternal (2 Cor. 4:18).

A heavenly mind is vital for a heavenly life. We were once totally bound to this earth. We cared nothing for the things of eternal worth. Our minds were totally on mundane, sinful, and temporal things. May God be ever thanked that we have died to our old life (Col. 3:3)!
