OUR BELIEFS

1. We believe the 66-book Bible is verbally inspired and inerrant in the original writings. We believe that the Bible must be interpreted literally, according to context, history, and grammar. We believe the dispensational approach to the Bible.
2. We believe there is one only living and true God, eternally existing in three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

7. We believe in the imminent, pretribulational rapture of the church. We believe in the personal, premillennial return of the Lord Jesus to the earth to set up His Kingdom.

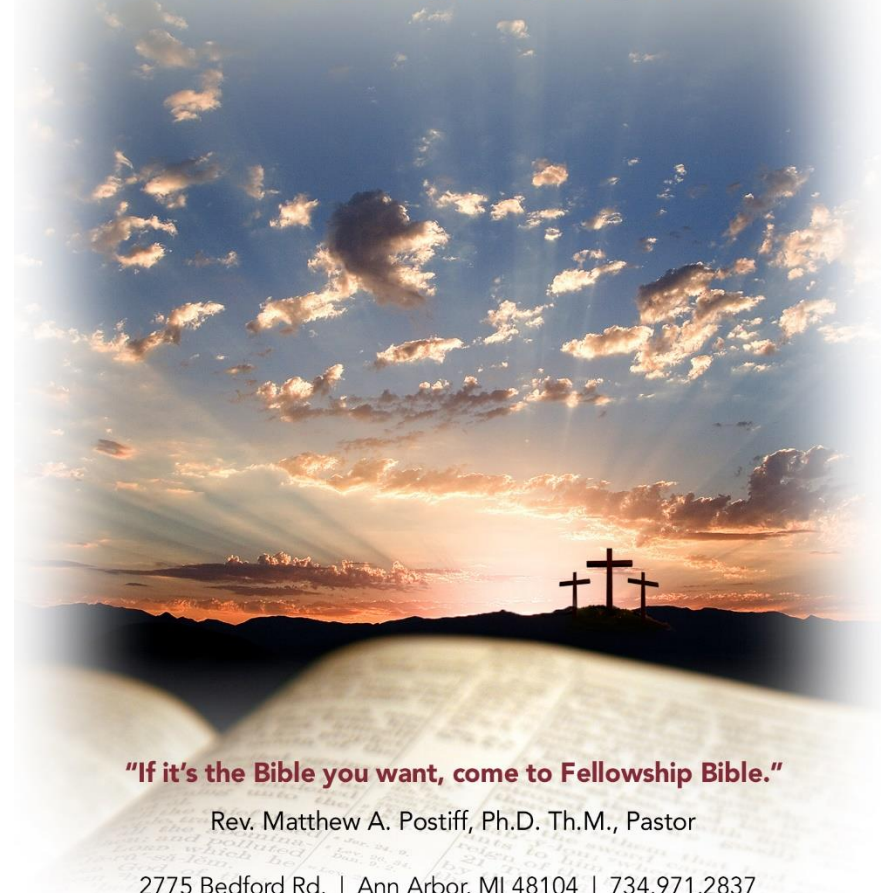
Ben Carnes and Jon Snoeberger are the deacons of Fellowship Bible Church.

DEVOTIONAL READING - God's Ways and My Delays - Proverbs 16:1-9

“A man's heart plans his ways, But the Lord directs his steps.” (Prov. 16:9).

Why is it so bothersome to be delayed or to have to wait? It's because we like to be in control and call the shots. Why should a traffic accident or a delayed flight ruin my carefully planned schedule? There are so many circumstances that we cannot control and our best laid plans often go up in smoke.

How helpful to remember that God is sovereign over everything that happens to us and around us. It's wise to plan ahead for each day, but our plans must always be subject to God's will and God's perfect timing. We need to be willing to let God delete our schedule and replace it with His. He knows what He wants us to do each day.

Perhaps there are ten things we planned to do on a certain day, and it can be frustrating to only accomplish two of them. Yet remember, there is always enough time in every day to do those things that God has for us to do. Not my schedule, but Thine be done! How we need to wait on the Lord and allow Him to bring people and circumstances into our lives which may change our course and alter our plans. God can take us away from doing what we wanted to do, and open up new opportunities to serve Him, even in unexpected ways.

We should allow the Lord to alter or even destroy our schedule. We can trust God, not just with big events, but also regarding trivial events which can tend to make us upset, irritated and impatient. When something unexpected happens, remember that God knows all about it and God is not taken by surprise. “My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from Him” (Psalm 62:5).
