OUR BELIEFS



2 Peter 1:1-11

- > The marriage equation: 1+1=1. "Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh" (Gen. 2:24; Eph. 5:31). What a wonderful bond!
