OUR BELIEFS

1. We believe the 66-book Bible is verbally inspired and inerrant in the original writings. We believe that the Bible must be interpreted literally, according to context, history, and grammar. We believe the dispensational approach to the Bible.

7. We believe in the imminent, pretribulational rapture of the church. We believe in the personal, premillennial return of the Lord Jesus to the earth to set up His Kingdom.

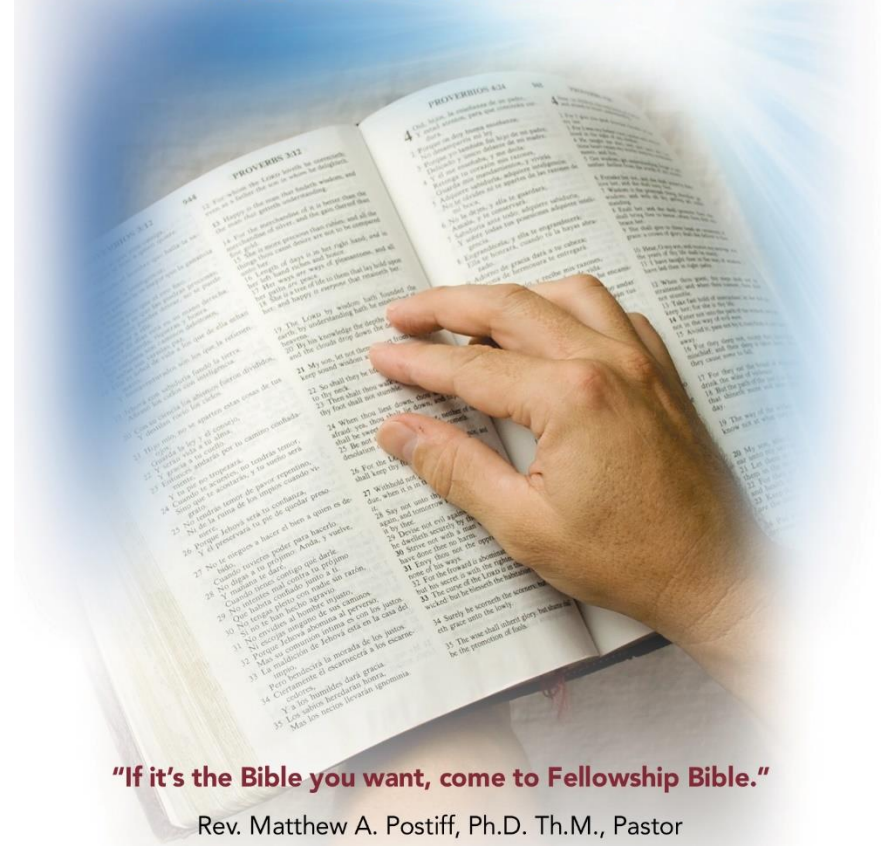
Ben Carnes and Jon Snoeberger are the deacons of Fellowship Bible Church.

DEVOTIONAL READING – Great Truths Expressed Through a Little Word “All”

1 Peter 5:1-11

What life-changing truths are expressed by the little three-letter word ALL! This convicting word condemns every one of us: “ALL we like sheep have gone astray....they are ALL gone out of the way....ALL have sinned and come short of the glory of God....ALL the world may become guilty before God” (Isa. 53:6; Rom. 3:12; 3:23).

Yet, this same word gives tremendous hope to every hell-deserving sinner: “[Jesus] is the Saviour of ALL men, specially of those that believe....the LORD hath laid on Him the iniquities of us ALL....Who will have ALL men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth....Who gave Himself a ransom for ALL” (1 Tim. 4:10; Isa. 53:6; 1 Tim. 2:4,6).

Moreover, the God of ALL grace is able to give the most welcoming invitation to lost men: “Come unto Me, ALL ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest....ALL that the Father giveth Me shall come to Me; and him that cometh to Me I will in no wise cast out” (Matt. 11:28; John 6:37). Even John 3:16 contains the phrase “whosoever believeth in Him” which literally may be rendered “ALL who believe in Him” or “everyone who believes in Him.”

Furthermore, this simple word is a great encouragement for daily living: “Casting ALL your care upon Him, for He careth for you” (1Pet. 5:7). “And God is able to make ALL grace abound toward you; that ye, always having ALL sufficiency in ALL things, may about to every good work” (2 Cor. 9:8).

And what a blessed future expectancy we have: “Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me ALL the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever” (Psalm 23:1). “God shall wipe away ALL tears from their eyes” (Rev. 21:4).
