OUR BELIEFS



DEVOTIONAL READING

Our nation is in turmoil due to a pandemic originating in China, and due to outbreaks of violence, looting, arson and racial unrest in American cities. Many other countries are experiencing similar troubles. The Holy Spirit through Paul said, "In the last days perilous [difficult] times shall come" (2 Tim. 3:1). To many it seems like we are living in very uncertain times. However, God's perspective is different. One Pastor wrote: "We don't live in uncertain times...These times are as certain as any time in all of human history, and the God of the universe laid out this time in great detail, point by point, and in fact, with all the detail needed by His people to live in times of absolute certainty! So no, there's nothing uncertain about the times in which we live to the believer who is seeking to live by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God."

Bible prophecy is falling in place right before our eyes with incredible accuracy. Did not God say that lawlessness would abound in the last days (Matt. 24:21)? Did not God predict that there would be pestilences (serious plagues and pandemics) prior to His Coming (Luke 21:11)? Remember, the Great Tribulation is soon to arrive, just after the Rapture of believers. It is described by Jesus as the greatest time of trouble the world has ever known (Matt. 24:21). Should we be surprised and shocked when we see such things beginning to come to pass? Our Lord has not left us in the dark. He has told us in advance what will happen (Matt.

24:25). God's prophetic Word is true and things are rapidly falling into place. To many, this world seems to be quickly spinning out of control. But be of good cheer, because our God is in complete control, and He will take care of His own!
